We reimburse our staff for any legitimate expenses incurred as part of their work.

We have a small number of UK suppliers that provide specialist support and services. These suppliers are assessed and approved in line with our supplier evaluation process to ensure their legitimacy. We do not provide products. Where we purchase products or ad-hoc services we use reputable national or local suppliers and make reasonable enquiries into their policy concerning modern slavery and human trafficking.

We will raise any suspected occurrences of modern slavery and human trafficking with the relevant authorities.
